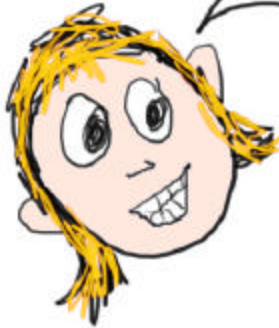


“Our shows help kids learn ...
